Autumn / Winter Trend Report

- Purples in a variety of hues from the red purple, into the deep royal purple and through to the purple blue.
- Jeans - team with a leather jacket, fitted or bomber style.
- The 1940's style; with pencil skirts and flowing belted dresses to emphasise the waist; blouses tucked into the pencil skirt and high waisted skirts, also brings attention to the waist, as does the belted trench coat.
- Cap sleeves on blouses with a tie falling over the bust and smock tops with puff sleeves. Blouses with a yolk or bib style in the front are also very popular.
- Knits are always popular in winter; knitted dresses worn with leggings and ankle boots.
